Transmission of business to Sensis Pty Ltd.

ORDER

A. Subject to the undertakings given by Sensis by letter to the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union (“ASU”) dated 19 April 2007, the Commission orders as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the transmission of business from each of the Applicants referred to below to Sensis Pty Ltd on or about 21 May 2007, Sensis Pty Ltd is not, will not be and has never been bound by the following industrial instruments that are currently binding on those respective Applicants in respect of any employee of any of the relevant Applicants who is offered and accepts employment with Sensis Pty Ltd in relation to the transmission.
