FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS ARISING FROM MEMBERSHIP

Members shall pay subscriptions fixed in the Branch rules in accordance with Nation Rule 19. Members shall pay any levies imposed in accordance with Rule 22 and the Branch Rules, and any fines imposed in accordance with Rule 36 and the Branch Rules.

RESIGNATION FROM THE UNION

A member may resign from membership by written notice addressed and delivered to the Branch Secretary.

A notice of resignation will take effect:

Where the member ceases to be eligible for membership of the Union, on the day on which the notice is received, or on the day specified in the notice, which is a day not earlier than the day on which the members ceases to be eligible to become a member, whichever is the later, OR, in any other case, at the end of 2 weeks, or on the day specified in the notice, whichever is later.

Any member resigning shall be liable for the payment of all subscriptions, fines and levies owing to the Union under the rules at the date of leaving, and such monies may be sued for and recovered in the name of the Union.

This document provides information to you regarding your account

By signing this direct debit request (DDR) you have authorised us to arrange for funds to be debited from your nominated account. You should refer to the direct debit request and this agreement for the terms of the arrangement between you and us.

Drawing arrangements

The ASU will debit amounts instructed by you on a selected Tuesday cycle. If the payment date is a non-business day or public holiday we will process a direct debit to your account on the next business day.

Changes to the arrangements

Unless you have asked us to change your payment and we have agreed to your request, we will give you at least 14 days notice when changes to our direct debit arrangements are made. This notice will include the new amount, frequency and the next drawing date.

A request to stop or alter direct debit arrangements must be made in writing to the ASU and signed by the member.
